

OLIVER: Mrs. Evelyn M., 87, formerly of St. Johnsbury and most recently of the Country Village Center in Lancaster, N.H., died in Lancaster Saturday, Jan. 19, 2002. She was born in St. Johnsbury Sept. 12, 1914, the daughter of Glenn G. and Almira (Perrigard) Woods. A graduate of St. Johnsbury Academy, Class of 1933, she married Herbert F. Oliver, April 25, 1937; he predeceased her July 29, 1991. Mrs. Oliver held several jobs in St. Johnsbury, retiring in 1981 after working at Hovey's Shops for 14 years.
