

FARR: Lucille A., 84, of Concord, Vt., died suddenly at her home, Wednesday evening, Sept. 11, 2002. She was born in Concord, Aug. 11, 1918, the daughter of Benjamin and Helen (Morton) Daniels. Shortly after birth she moved to Waterford to the Daniels Brothers Farm, where she lived for many years. Lucille married Collins J. Farr and from 1962 to 1981 they lived in the Barre Town area, working for Sprague Electric, then returning to Concord.
