

Ralph H. Peters passed away Thursday evening, Dec. 16, 2010 at the St. Johnsbury Health & Rehab Center at the age of 91. He was formerly a resident of High Street in St. Johnsbury. He was born in St. Johnsbury on Feb. 4, 1919, one of seven sons born to Walter and Mary (Ramsey) Peters. Ralph served in the Army's 978th Field Artillery Battalion in the European theatre during WWII. He worked for years in the dial room at Fairbanks.
