ADAMS: Marion H., 81, formerly of Heaton Woods, Montpelier, died Monday evening, July 7, 2003, at Rowan Court Health and Rehabilitation Center in Barre. She moved to Montpelier from East Burke in 1982. Mrs. Adams was born in Lyndon Center May 24, 1922, the daughter of Leon and Kate (Balentine) Hopkins.
