



Elizabeth M. "Betty" Moulton, of Main Street in St. Johnsbury, passed away Saturday, June 10, 2006. Born in Johnson on Oct. 7, 1923, Betty was one of eight children born to Alfred and Helen (Bailey) Shore. Five of her siblings predeceased her: William "Xerxes," Francis, Alfred "Gator," Bailey "Sonny," and Lucretia "Kitty." A 1941 graduate of St. Johnsbury Academy, she served in the Marines during WWII. Her husband, Burt, died in 1964 when she was only 41. Many may remember Betty working at the Village Washtub and at the Fairbanks Museum Gift Shop. In her early working years, she was employed at St. Johnsbury Trucking.
