

## Charles Moulton - Obituary

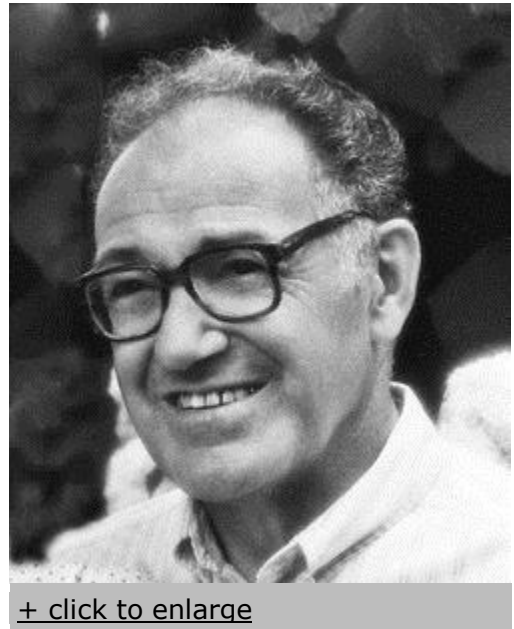
Charles R. Moulton of School Street in St. Johnsbury passed away peacefully at home Monday, Aug. 26, 2013, at the age of 89.
