

**CLARK GRAVEL: Anita M. (Langlois)**, 75, a resident of Springfield, Mass. for over 53 years and formerly of St. Johnsbury, died early Tuesday morning at Baystate Medical Center in Springfield. She was born in St. Johnsbury, the daughter of the late George and Josephine (Boucher) Langlois, and was a graduate of St. Johnsbury Academy, Class of 1945.
