Rev. Edward J. Hart, 82, died on July 6, 2010, following a long illness. He was born on December 19, 1927, in St. Johnsbury, Vt., the son of Edward and Jeanne (Asselin) Hart. He then served with the Glenmary Missionaries in parishes in Texas and Mississippi from 1988 to 1992. He was granted Senior Priest Status in 1992, but continued to assist in parishes and provided priestly ministry at St. Joseph Home in Burlington, until 2005. He is survived by a sister, Mary Servin of South Pasadena, Calif., and her family.
