

SPRINGFIELD - Janet M. Liberty, 85, a longtime resident of Springfield, died Sunday, Sept. 20, 2015, at Springfield Health and Rehabilitation Center.

She was born May 20, 1930, in St. Johnsbury, the daughter of George R. and Doris Abbie (Wheaton) Moore. She received her schooling in St. Johnsbury and graduated from St. Johnsbury Academy in 1948. She later attended the Community College of Vermont in Springfield.
