

Roland Richard Heon, 86, died on Sunday, December 20, 2015 at Roman Eagle Rehabilitation and Health Care Center. Born April 28, 1929, in St. Johnsbury, Vermont, he was the son of Albert J. Heon and Rosilda Bedard Heon. He was a resident of Danville, VA since 1980, and retired in 1991 as manager/owner of Value City Department Store.
