

Pauline Urie of Passumpsic passed away at home, unexpectedly and peacefully, Tuesday, March 9, 2010, at the age of 78. She was born in Springfield, Mass., on Nov. 11, 1931. Pauline was one of three children born to Peter and Eva (Smith) Morrison. Her brother, Ray Morrison, and sister, Barbara Butcher, both predeceased her. She was married to Bernard Urie; he predeceased her May 11, 1993. Her granddaughter Heidi died in 1989. Pauline graduated from St. Johnsbury Academy in 1949.
