

Marion Warrell Daines, 77, formerly of East Barnet, Vt., died on Jan. 3, 2010 in Sacramento, Calif. Ms. Daines was born Oct. 25, 1932, where she lived on the dairy farm with her parents, William and Mary Warden Warrell. After graduating with the St. Johnsbury Academy Class of 1950, she then graduated from the University of Vermont in the initial class of the School of Dental Hygiene.
