

## Death Notice - Bruce Hoyt

Bruce W. Hoyt, 79, of Safety Harbor, Fla., passed away peacefully in his home on Jan. 23, 2016. Bruce was born in St. Johnsbury, Vt. on March 7, 1936 to Herman and Elsie (Darling) Hoyt. He graduated from Tufts University and served in the US Navy from 1958-1961. Later, he received his Masters of Science in Physics from the University of Wisconsin. Bruce was a life-long teacher.
