St. Johnsbury, VT- Dale H. Chamberlain, 81, a longtime resident of St. Johnsbury passed away peacefully at St. Johnsbury Health and Rehab on July 12, 2016 He was born March 28, 1935 the son of Harvey and Sadie (Paris) Chamberlain in Lyndonville, VT.
