Lawrence G. "Larry" Mayo of Lyndonville, Vt. died Wednesday morning, June 13, 2007, at the Pines Rehabilitation & Health Center in Lyndon, Vt. at the age of 71. He was born April 12, 1936, in Lyndon, Vt. a son of the late Leroy and Arlene (Humphrey) Mayo. A graduate of Lyndon Institute's Class of 1954, Larry then entered the U.S. Army serving his country during the Korean War. On July 7, 1956, he married Beverly J. Morse.
