

Nancy Moore of Lyndonville, longtime Lyndon State College accountant, passed away at the Grafton County Nursing Home Sunday, Sept. 20, 2015 at the age of 79.

Nancy was born in St. Johnsbury on Jan. 23, 1936, one of two daughters born to George Raymond and Doris (Wheaton) Moore. Ironically her older sister, Janet Moore Liberty, passed away on the same day only two hours after Nancy.

Nancy graduated from St. Johnsbury Academy with the class of 1955 and went on to obtain her degree from Bentley College. Nancy was an excellent, quilter and craft person. She exhibited many of her crafts at local county fairs. Nancy had a life long passion for gardening, decorating, and playing the piano. Nancy was also an expert seamstress
