

**ST. CYR: Priscilla R. (Ranney)**, 62, of East St. Johnsbury (P.O. Box 2, 05838), died at Northeastern Vermont Regional Hospital early Thursday morning, June 7, 2001. She was born in Concord, Vt., Sept. 1, 1938, the daughter of Russell and Lura (Dresser) Ranney, and graduated from St. Johnsbury Academy in 1956.
