

**Frank Arthur Brunelle**, 72, of Barton died on May 10, 2011, in St. Johnsbury. He was born February 5, 1939, in St. Johnsbury, a son of Alfred and Viola (Bean) Brunelle. On August 23, 1958, he married Lorraine Giguere who survives him. Mr. Brunelle graduated from St. Johnsbury Academy in 1957 and attended one year at the University of Vermont. He was a merchandiser for Nabisco for 20 years.
