

MACHELL: Lucy A. (Larocque), 64, of St. Johnsbury, died Saturday evening, Sept. 18, 2004, at Northeastern Vermont Regional Hospital in St. Johnsbury. She was born in Sutton, Vt., July 11, 1940, daughter of the late Donald O. and Beatrice (Labor) Larocque Sr. Lucy was schooled in Barnet and attended Mt. St. Joseph Academy in St. Johnsbury. Lucy was an active member of the VFW Post 793 auxiliary in St. Johnsbury and was a past Vermont State President, National Council Member, and Vermont State Secretary. She was also active in the American Legion Post 30 of Lyndon for many years. Known as the family historian for the Larocque family, Lucy was instrumental in the coordination of the University of Vermont Medical School's study of the Larocque Syndrome Blood Disease. She loved spending time with her three grandsons, her family and her friends. Lucy also loved her feline companions who brought her much joy. Survivors include her two children, Barbara A.
