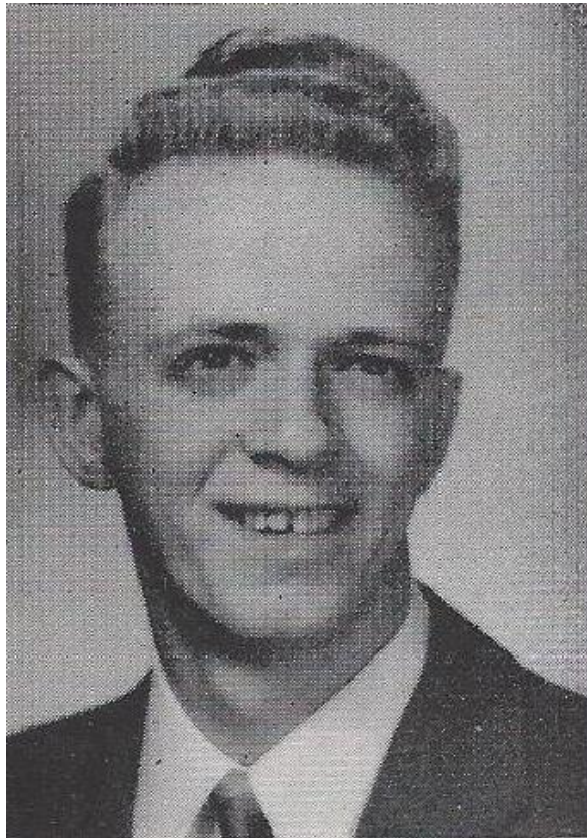


## **Lawrence A. "Sonny" Noyes**

Lawrence A. "Sonny" Noyes, 70, of Lyndonville, died Saturday evening, June 1, 2013, at the VA Hospital in White River Jct., Vt.

He was born Dec. 4, 1942, in Sutton, the son of Herman and Vera (Bundy) Noyes. He graduated from St. Johnsbury Trade School in 1961. On Jan. 20, 1962, he married Lois Dwyer.

Larry served his country in the U.S. Navy during the Vietnam War. He worked as an electrician here in the Northeast and also while he was

out west during the 1980s and into the 1990s totaling 50 years as an electrician. He was active in the Electrical Union IBEW and was a member of the American Legion Post 30 of Lyndonville. Hunting, fishing and spending time with family and friends was very important to Larry.
