

Michael Kennedy Obituary

Michael J. Kennedy, of St. Johnsbury, passed away on Jan. 18, 2012 at the St. Johnsbury Health and Rehabilitation Center at the age of 68.

Michael was born on December 2, 1943 in San Antonio, Texas, the son of Harold W. and Marylyn (Sleeper) Kennedy. He was predeceased by his parents and a nephew.

He graduated from St. Johnsbury Academy in 1961. Additionally he received degrees in Accounting as a graduate of Bentley College and the University of Vermont.
