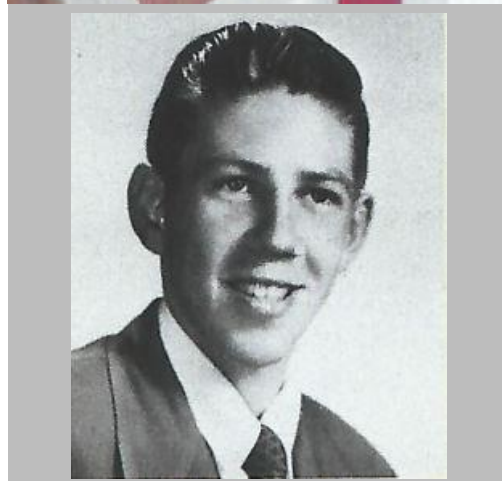


David E. Hamel - Obituary
