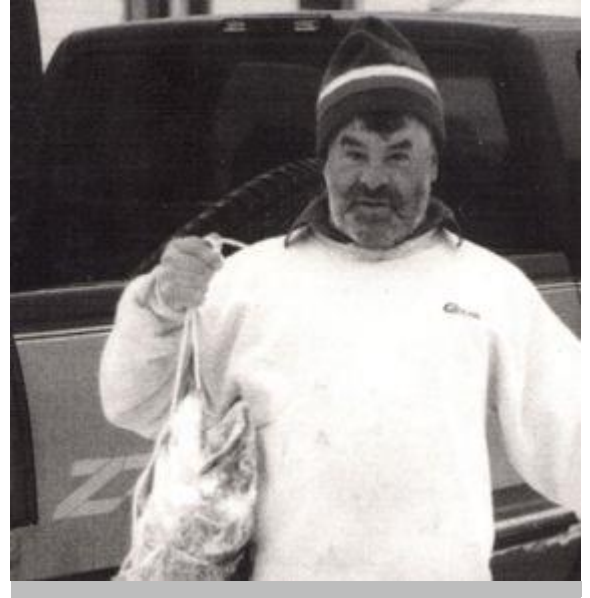
Harry was predeceased by his parents, Lyman and Annie Crown.
