



Anne Margaret Roy of Lyndonville passed away early Friday, Sept. 3, 2010, at Dartmouth Hitchcock Medical Center after being diagnosed with cancer three weeks prior. She was born in Burlington on May 28, 1954, the adopted daughter of Theodore and Belle (Vance) Perrigard. Her father Ted passed away in 1990, her mother Belle in the year 2000. Following her graduation from St. Johnsbury Academy in 1972, Anne met Ghislain E. Roy of Norton while he was an Army recruiter in St. Johnsbury. She and Ghislain were married April 30, 1973.
