

KITTREDGE: Ronald J. "Ronnie," 48, of 789 Railroad St., St. Johnsbury, passed away suddenly early Saturday, May 31, 2003. He was born in St. Johnsbury Sept. 13, 1954, the son of A. Ray and Margaret (Hayes) Kittredge. He was a 1972 graduate of St. Johnsbury Academy. After operating Ideal Upholstery and the Benjamin Moore Paint Store on Eastern Avenue, Ronnie did business as R & L Enterprises, which entailed his upholstery business, painting, snow removal, rental properties, fire apparatus sales, and a pavement marking business which he operated all over New Hampshire and Vermont, and serviced several area towns' pavement marking needs.
