



**LOUISVILLE, Ky.** — Susan McClaughry died Monday, Nov. 16, 2015, at a Louisville, Kentucky hospital after a lifelong battle with lung disease.

Susan was the daughter of the Rev. Alice Roberts of Newport and John McClaughry of Kirby, Vermont. She was born Sept. 15, 1977, at the Medical Center Hospital of Vermont in Burlington and grew up in Kirby, Vermont. She spent her freshman year at St. Johnsbury Academy, two years at Rindge and Latin High School in Cambridge, Massachusetts, and her senior year at St. Johnsbury Academy, where she graduated in the Class of 1995. She graduated from the University of North Carolina – Charlotte with an A.B. in psychology in 1999.
